I'm so sad and discouraged. I don't know if I can go on... A timid but hopeful voice greeted me from the other end of the line.

I was going to the van to put my cell-phone there so it wouldn't interrupt my Sunday afternoon nap. Just as I was leaving the van my phone began to ring.

Thoughts of a nap were

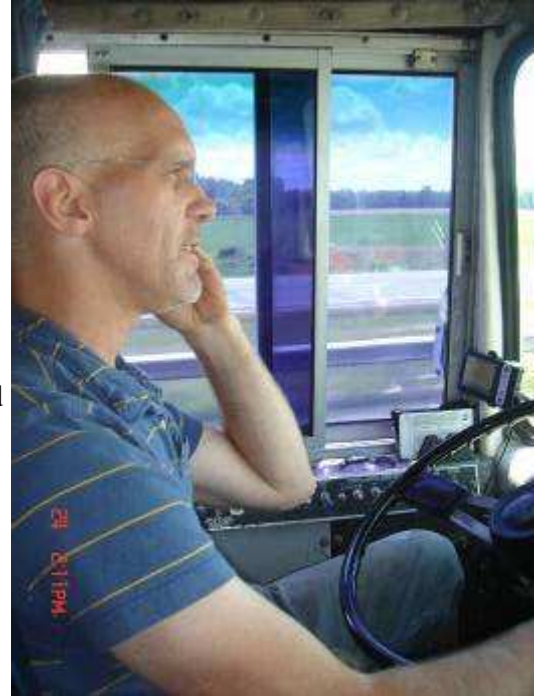
quickly shelved as the young married man sadly described the pain of pornography addiction. I empathised as hurt, pain, anguish, extreme frustration and sadness poured out of his heart. His hopelessness and discouragement could be felt in spite of the distance. His tone betrayed resignation and hopelessness.

I spoke of the hope and freedom I've found using my testimony. I've been sharing this for the last number of years. He listened attentively and when I paused he asked, "**Does it really work?**" "I've been free for 15 years now and I am enjoying the freedom more now than ever. YES, it is possible to be free and pure in your thought life." I replied. As he embraced the truth I could sense hope rising in him. A spark came into his voice. I sensed a life change beginning. He called

last week to thank me after receiving some follow up material. Thank you for the opportunity Lord.

The amazing thing was, how did he catch me going to the van, (especially on a Sunday afternoon) from overseas, a different time zone completely.

God is moving in Concord, North Carolina. Drew is completing his internship with a School of Ministry and will graduate the end of July. I have one more year of school to complete.

What we are doing? God led Drew to work at a small Baptist church two and a half years ago. This church has blessed us in many ways. Drew is the youth pastor, and I lead the worship. Discipleship is the most important thing to us. We want to build strong Christians more than we want a *big* youth group. We started with two kids and presently are at ten, touching many more. The youth group grew almost entirely

Last summer, a girl who has grown up in the church had been reaching out to a homosexual boy at her school. After praying for him, he ended up coming and turning his heart to the Lord, completely being freed from depression and homosexuality. We began to pray for their friend, a girl in the hospital for attempted suicide. A couple weeks later, the new convert, excited about evangelism and taking classes on it at the church, was hanging out with the girl and got to lead her to the Lord! She is involved in the church today, running sound on Sunday's. A few months later, she began bringing one of her

friends, with an extremely tough home situation, to the youth group. We began praying for her and two months ago (after being in the youth group for four months) she gave her heart to the Lord! All are growing, and need your prayers.

Drew is running a Bible study called "Bible Skate," on Monday nights at a local skate park. He has 25-30 kids coming every week. A couple weeks ago eight gave their hearts to the Lord. Wow!

Pray for us, for wisdom as our youth face *many difficult* circumstances. All need God's protection over their hearts as there is much temptation. Pray for spiritual, numeric growth, and salvation for most of our youths' families.

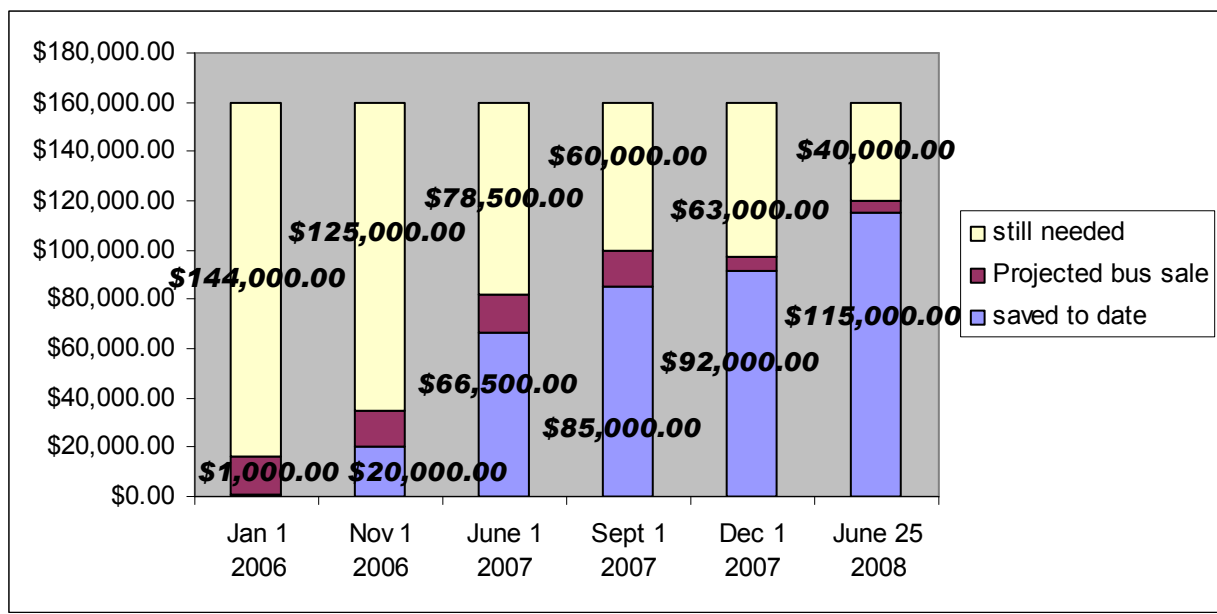
